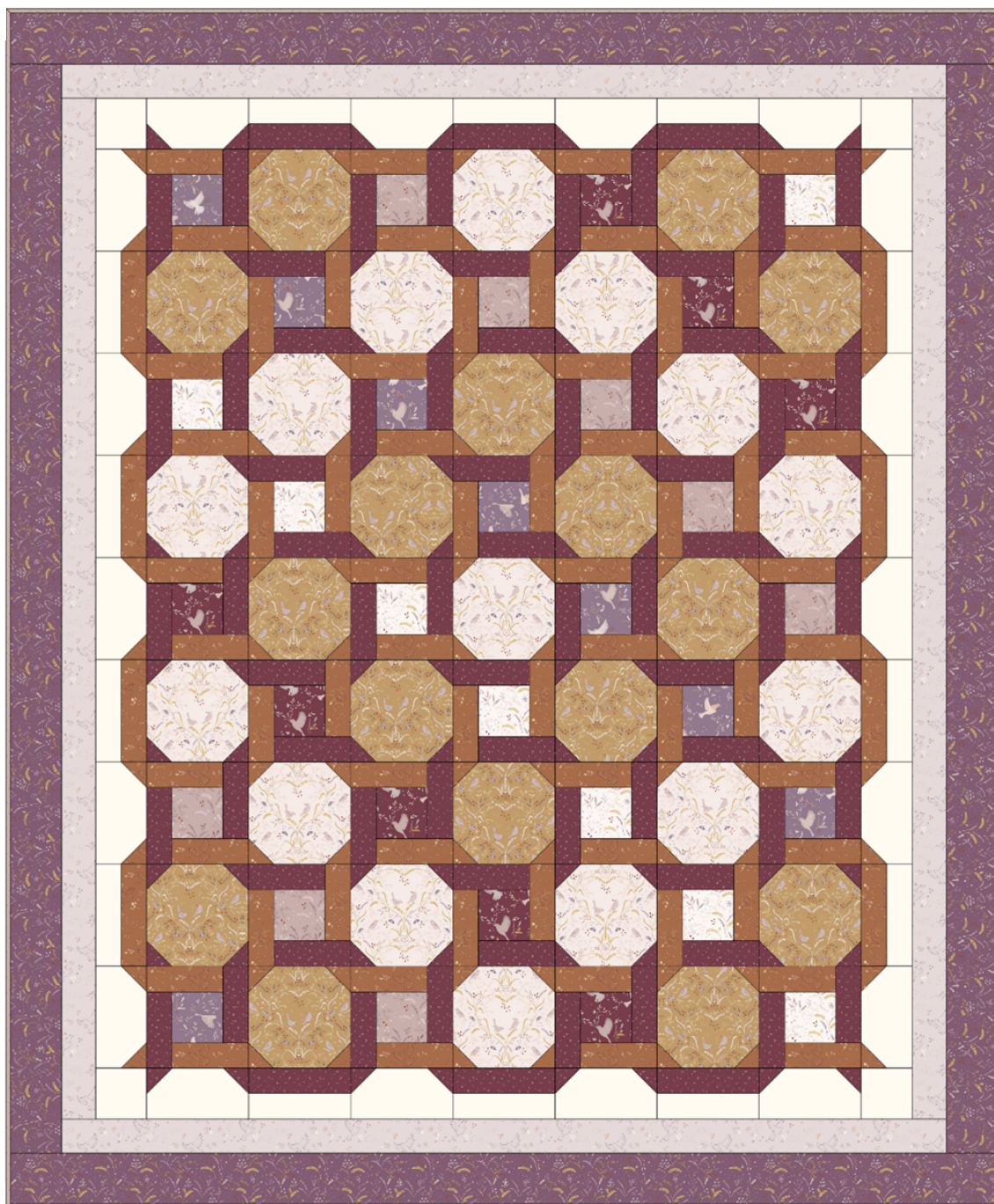

# Requirements

Fabrics from Meadowside collection

1. CC6.1 - Bird by Bird on Ecru Pink - 70cm
2. CC6.2 - Bird by Bird on Mustard - 60cm
3. CC7.2 - Meadow Call on Lavender - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
4. CC7.3 - Meadow Call on Wine - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
5. CC8.1 - Grassfield Gathering on Light Ecru Pink - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
6. CC8.2 - Grassfield Gathering on Light Deep Purple Taupe - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
7. CC8.3 - Grassfield Gathering on Mauve Taupe -  $1\frac{1}{4}$  m
8. CC9.2 - Seeds of Solitude on Light Purple Taupe - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
9. CC9.3 - Seeds of Solitude on Wine -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
10. CC10.1 - Small Seeds Dusty Linen - 70cm
11. CC10.3 - Small Seeds Rusty Orange -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
12. Cream fabric - 60cm

Wadding and backing 62" x 74"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut  
15 x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 2 cut  
16 x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 3 cut  
8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (For block 1)

From fabric 4 cut  
8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (For block 1)

From fabric 5 cut  
8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (For block 1)

From fabric 6 cut  
8 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (For block 1)

From fabric 7 cut  
6 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (outer border)

From fabric 8

Binding

From fabric 9 cut  
6 x 2" x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (border)  
64 x 2" x 5" (block 1)  
80 x 2" x 2" (block 2 and border)

From fabric 10 cut  
6 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (inner border)

From fabric 11 cut  
 8 x 2" x 6½" (border)  
 40 x 2" H x 5" W (block 1)  
 24 x 2" W x 5" H (block 1)  
 80 x 2" x 2" (block 2 and border)

From fabric 12 cut  
 18 x 2" x 6½" (border)  
 14 x 2" x 6½" (border)  
 4 x 3½" x 3½" (corners)

## Blocks

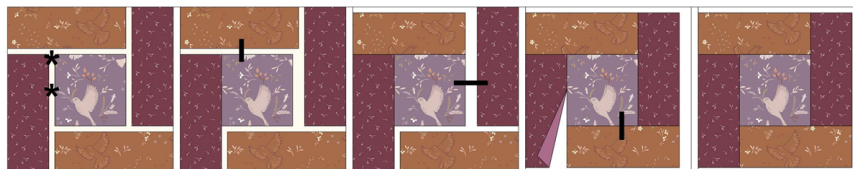


Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1 as in the main diagram.



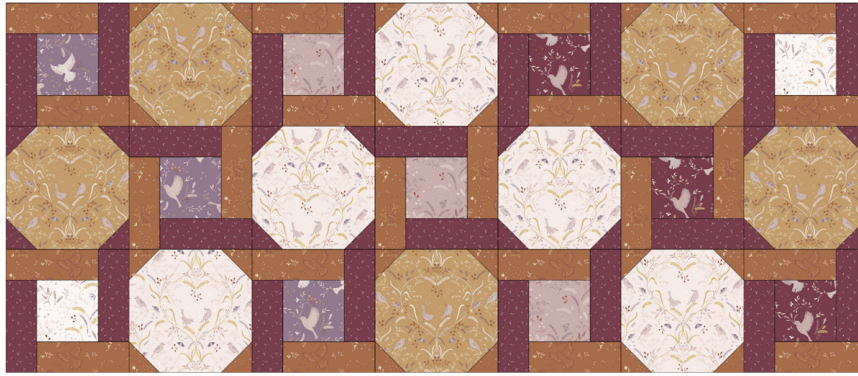
Start on the left side. Place the square onto the left-hand strip and sew down from the top for about an inch. Finger press back. Next the top strip, press back. Keep working around the centre square until all the strips are attached to the centre square. Stitch the last bit of the strip to the block. 32 blocks in total, but look at the fabric placement for each bloc as in the main diagram.

Block 2 - Take 4 x 2" x 2" of fabric 11, draw a diagonal line on the back of the squares. Next place onto the fabric 2 in each corner.

Stitch down the pencil line and cut a ¼" seam away from the stitched line, press. 31 blocks in total, but look at the fabric placement for each block as in the main diagram.

## Making up the Quilt

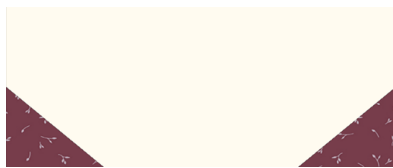
Lay out all the block for the quilt center. Sew in rows press the seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together.



The top 3 rows of the quilt.

## Borders

Inner border

Do the same as before with placing the squares onto your strip of background fabric. Stitch, trim and press. 16 with fabric 12 and 20 with fabric 15. Sew the strips together as in the main diagram, but on the top and bottom add the squares to each end. Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

Middle border

Join the strips for the sides -  $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 60\frac{1}{2}$ " sew to the quilt  
For the top and bottom -  $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 52\frac{1}{2}$ " stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Outer border

This is made up as the middle border.  
For the sides you need -  $2 \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times 64\frac{1}{2}$ " sew to quilt and for the top and bottom -  $2 \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times 58\frac{1}{2}$ " stitch this to the quilt to complete your quilt top.

## Quilting and Binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.  
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Use your favorite method from fabric 8 to bind the quilt.
