Throw 1: Size of throw 50" x 50" Unfinished block size 9½" x 9½"

Requirements

Fabrics from Sky Garden collection.

- 1. CC56.1 Sky Garden Cream 14/yd 14/m
- 2. CC57.2 Floral Odyssey Light Burnt Sienna 3/8yd 40cm
- 3. CC58.3 Scattered Sprig Taupe -3/8yd 40cm
- 4. CC59.3 Ivy Trail Deep Teal -3/8yd 40cm
- 5. CC60.1 Wintersweet Pale Peach 3/8yd 40cm
- 6. Background fabric 1 5/8yd 1½m

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.



Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
2 x 2½" x 50½" top & bottom border
2 x 2½" x 46½" sides
20 x 4" x 4"
5 x 3½" x 3½"

From each of the fabrics 2,3,4 and 5 you need to cut $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46½" sides 20×4 " x 4"

From the background fabric cut $2 \times 1" \times 46\%"$ top & bottom - inner border $2 \times 1" \times 45\%"$ sides - inner border $100 \times 4" \times 4"$

Making up the blocks

Take the 4" x 4" squares of a background and pattern fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the background fabric.

Place the two fabric squares together and stitch a ¼" seam each side of the pencil line, press the seam.

Trim back to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. All the part blocks will be made up like this. Lay out in rows and then sew the rows together to make the block.

You need 5 blocks in total of each colour way.

Making up the throw

Lay out all the blocks Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows and then the sew the rows together to complete the throw center.

Inner and outer border.

Sew the side strips to the throw, press. Next add the top and bottom. Do the same to the outer border to complete the throw top.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired.

Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 1 to bind the throw.

- 2. CC57.3 Floral Odyssey Deep Teal 3/8yd 40cm
- 3. CC58.1 Scattered Sprig Cream -3/8yd 40cm
- 4. CC59.2 Ivy Trail Misty Jade -3/8yd 40cm
- 5. CC60.3 Wintersweet Light Burnt Sienna- 3/8yd 40cm
- 6. Background fabric 1 5/8yd 1½m

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50½" top & bottom border $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46½" sides 20×4 " x 4" $5 \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the background fabric cut $2 \times 1" \times 46\%"$ top & bottom - inner border $2 \times 1" \times 45\%"$ sides - inner border $100 \times 4" \times 4"$

- 5. CC60.2 Wintersweet Light Burnt Sienna 3/8yd 40cm
